



RECEIVING HOLY EUCHARIST: With our younger parishioners in the final stages of preparation to begin receiving the gift of Holy Eucharist each week, it might be a good time to remind ourselves of how WE receive this gift each week. Specifically, nobody 'takes' the Eucharist. It is a gift. It is received. Practically, that means the Minister of Holy Communion places the Sacrament on our hand after we respond "Amen" to the "Body of Christ". We then immediately put it into our mouth, or take one step to the side and, facing the Altar, put it into our mouth (NEVER while walking away). It is never appropriate to take the Eucharist from the hand of the Minister, unless there is a medical reason why we cannot receive it in the palm of our hand.
