## **RECONCILIATION—HOLY EUCHARIST—CONFIRMATION**

Registration forms for Reconciliation, Holy Eucharist and Confirmation are now available from Fr. Michael for those who wish to begin their formation for these Sacraments. The deadline for their return is fast approachingdo not wait to ask for a registration form—now is the best time to get it.



Anyone who will be age seven or older by the end of 2018 may begin their preparation for Reconciliation/Eucharist. This is a year earlier than in the past.

Anyone who will be age twelve or older—usually those going into Grade 7—by the end of 2018 may begin their preparation for Confirmation.

Registration forms for these Sacraments are available from Fr. Michael following any Sunday Mass—iust ask him for one at the door. They will not be available anywhere else.

Registration forms for Reconciliation/Eucharist may be requested by the primary care giver of the child who will be preparing. Registration forms for Confirmation must be requested by the candidate who is asking to be Confirmed. Registration forms must be returned no later than September 23rd—don't wait until the Fall to ask Fr. Michael for one.




