We know that cuts to the Sudbury Breast Screening Assessment Service will result in longer wait times which is very stressful for women diagnosed with breast cancer. We are responding to the call to **make our voices heard.** THIS weekend, there is a petition at the back of the Church to sign asking the government to **provide adequate funding to Health Sciences North** to ensure northerners have equitable access to lifesaving programs.

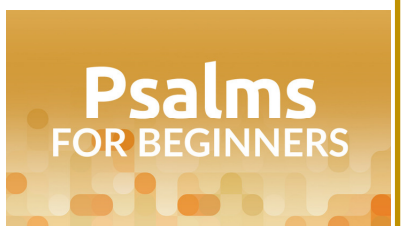
CHIT CHAT AND COFFEE: Our topic of discussion this coming Friday was submitted via e-mail: *“Can we discuss, faith is not an individual journey, it is a team sport. We need each other. We are on this journey together. We need a community to help us reach our goal”*. We will begin with this, and see where our conversation



This will be a new, weekly feature of our Parish bulletin. It will highlight various aspects of our faith, tradition, liturgy, theology, etc., that we likely all knew at some point, but may have forgotten. And so, we will have weekly reminders.

Such as this one: **There is a one hour fast prescribed before receiving Holy Eucharist. The fast does not include medicine or water, but does include all other food and drink. The intention is to prepare ourselves physically, spiritually and emotionally to receive the greatest Gift: The Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord. (Those a bit older might remember when the fast began at Midnight).**

LEARN TO PRAY WITH THE PSALMS: Our Tuesday evening and Thursday afternoon Faith Sharing Groups will wrap up the final week of November. Following this, Fr. Michael will be offering a 3 night course on the Psalms of David. This will take place on Tuesday night beginning at 7pm in the Parish Meeting Room on December 4th, 11th and 18th. There is no registration required. Participants are asked to bring their own Bible or Book of Psalms. All other resources will be provided.



Following this, beginning in January, we will begin praying the Divine Liturgy (Morning Prayer) before some of our weekday Masses. Those who attend the 3 evenings in December will learn how to read and pray the Psalms, how to understand the poetry and rhythmic patterns in them, including their unique form of rhyme, and will come to appreciate how they formed the basis for the Prayer life of Jesus, and have continued to be the Prayer of the Church to this day.
