
This Sunday Missal will be a useful aid, parents, as you help to prepare your children to approach the Table of the Eucharist in 2019.

A reverence is always made before we receive Holy Eucharist. While the 1 hour fast prepares us for what we soon will receive, the reverence acknowledges the profound Gift that is now being offered to us. It is a sign of respect, and reminds us that the Gift about to be received is no ordinary event. It is a Divine exchange, whereby the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ enters into us.

The usual reverence made (in our Diocese) is a simple bow. It is normally done when the person in front of us is receiving, so as not to interrupt the flow of Communicants. It is also made before we receive from the Chalice, if we choose to receive Eucharist that way.
