EPIPHANY HOUSE BLESSING: Take a piece of the blessed chalk home. Over the doorway of your house, or of a room frequently used, inscribe 20 + C + M + B + 19. As a reminder, the first and last numbers are the year we now are in, and the letters are the first initials (by tradition) of the Magi: Caspar of India, Melchior of Persia, and Balthasar of Arabia. Alternatively, they can also represent "Christus Mansionem Benedicat" or Christ, Bless this House. You may pray in this way before or after you make the inscription: Bless, O Lord God almighty, this home, that in it there may be health, purity, the strength of victory, humility, goodness and mercy, the fulfillment of Your law, the thanksgiving to God the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. And may this blessing remain upon this home and upon all who dwell in it, and upon all who visit here. Through Christ our Lord.

CHIT CHAT AND COFFEE:

This activity is cancelled for Friday this week, as well as the Friday following. It will resume on January 25th.

We tend to associate the Feast of Epiphany with the arrival of the Magi in Matthew's Gospel. Traditionally, however, there are two additional Mysteries associated with this Feast Day: The



Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River by John the Baptist (with the Divine declaration made by the Voice from Heaven-a Mystery we now celebrate separately next weekend) and the changing of the water into wine at the wedding banquet of Cana (first sign that Jesus performs). All three are events that point to the Mystery of the revelation of God made visible.


