

## A NOTE ON MASS INTENTIONS:

A Pastor is obligated to celebrate a Mass for the Intentions of all his Parishioners every Sunday. He is also permitted to accept only one Mass Stipend (offering) per day. Given that St. Bernardine's Parish only has one Mass/week celebrated in their Parish, they always get preference for scheduling a Mass intention on

that day. That means the other Sunday Mass at St. John's must be a Missa Pro Populo (for the people). The only time a Mass intention can be scheduled on a Sunday at St. John's is if there happens to be no Mass scheduled for that day at St. Bernardine's. So, if you specifically ask for a Sunday Mass in Garson, you will likely be waiting for some time. And if you ask for a specific Sunday, you likely will not be able to have it on that day.

The precepts regarding fasting (Ash Wednesday and Good Friday) bind all Roman Catholics between the ages of 18—59. The one hour fast before Communion binds everyone regardless of age (only water and medicines are permitted). The precepts regarding abstinence (no meat on Fridays) bind all Roman Catholics who are 14 and older. In Canada, Catholics may substitute the Friday Abstinence with another act of piety, although no such substitution may be made on Good Friday.
