With the one bag/week garbage limit beginning in October, we will embark on a renewed effort to reduce our waste, primarily by diverting as much as possible to the Blue Box and Green Bin. Please be respectful of the signs which are posted to indicate the container that should be used. Since the Church does not receive garbage pick up, whatever we produce is discarded with Fr. Michael's pick up. Your assistance in reducing our waste is appreciated.

With the Federal Election coming in October, the Canadian Bishops have written a guide to help Roman Catholics make an informed decision re: voting through the prism of our faith. It does not tell us HOW to vote, but is rather a reflection on how to discern for ourselves how to vote, based on Gospel teachings.
