

ADOPT A BABY:

New prayer cards are now available in the main entranceway of the Church for those who wish to adopt an unborn baby this year. This is a spiritual response, encouraged by Bishop Fulton Sheen, to one of the greatest evils of our time.

Very simply, you pray about and then choose a name for the unborn child you are adopting. Write the name on the left side of the slip of paper: blue paper for a boy and pink paper for a girl. Cut at the dotted line. Return the left side to the Parish Office. Keep the right side, and pray the prayer that is there every day for your adopted child.

negotiation, depending on the needs and abilities of the woman or man who wishes to volunteer. This can be a team Ministry, or a Ministry of one. It can be one that simply organizes, calls forth others, and plans, or it can be hands on and "I'll take care of it myself". If you are intrigued, interested or mildly curious, please speak to Fr. Michael at your convenience.

The Parish Pastoral Council has decided this approach would be the 'ideal' for our Parish. However, lacking a volunteer, the PPC is also open to the possibility of hiring a part time maintenance/care taker for the Parish. This could be an expanded role that includes cleaning the Church and Hall, and even one that includes snow removal and/or grass cutting. All options are open; we will simply adapt what jobs are possible to whoever is interested. Again, please speak to Fr. Michael if this might interest you.

Michael to retrieve it for you at any other time. For those who wish to switch to automatic donations, there are forms available for that in the entranceway of the Church. For those who wish to begin using weekly envelopes, there are boxes available in the Church - just ask Fr. Michael or a Minister of Hospitality for one.


