A WORD FROM FR. MICHAEL

This weekend, Pentecost, marks the conclusion of the Easter Season. It was also the time our Bishop had planned on being in our Parish to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation with those who had been prepared to receive this Gift. While we will still celebrate the great Feast (at home), sadly, we are unable this weekend to welcome our Bishop and witness him Confirm our young parishioners.

Further, with Bishop Marcel moving to Ottawa in two weeks to take up his new responsibilities there, it will be a new Bishop (unknown to us at this time) who eventually will visit our parish and Confirm our parishioners. More unknowns; more surprises; more plans changed by events beyond our control. And isn't that our life?

If there is one lesson taught by the pandemic washing over the earth, it's that our control of our lives is an illusion. A comforting illusion, no doubt; one carefully nurtured and used to buffer ourselves from that most disquieting reality: that we ultimately are not in control. God is the Master of our lives and of the universe, and we can bow only to Him.

There is an old saying: we plan, God laughs. It's not meant to disparage our planning or to belittle God as uncaring or overly controlling. Rather, it speaks of the smallness of our plans in relation to the immensity of God, and His desire for us to live in His immensity. He calls us beyond our limitations to participate in the fullness of Who He Is; to live in His Love.

It is the Holy Spirit Who enables us to do precisely this. By God's grace, we already dwell in that Love of God. If you like, we can glimpse in the here and now the glory that awaits us. It happens daily, if we have eyes to see. It's about allowing ourselves to be surprised by God.

Have you ever been surprised by God? Have your eyes ever suddenly opened to recognize Him in the person before you, in the situation at hand, in the curveballs of life? If you have, then you know what it means to glimpse the Omnipresence of the One Who Is all in all. God's surprises are a grace whereby we become more certain of His reality, His concern for us, His love and His peace. One of the joys of being Christian is to live moment by moment in the firm expectation of God's surprises. The spiritual life is really that of a soul constantly keeping watch for the Beloved; one that learns to 'tune in' to recognize Him.

This Sunday, Pentecost, we continue to rejoice that Christ, having risen from the dead, is present in all places and is filling all things. Through the Holy Spirit, we are able to recognize this reality, live in it each moment, and respond to it with joy.
