2021 Donation Envelopes

We are making the donation envelopes for 2021 available a bit earlier than usual this year, to allow for a different way of distributing them. We will not put them all out at once, as that only leads to people touching more envelopes than their own. We are doing our best to minimize any chance of spreading germs.

So, beginning next weekend, your box of donation envelopes will be placed on the entranceway table in the Church IF you have either e-mailed or called the office, leaving a message asking for your envelopes to be left there.

In your message, please leave your name and specify the Mass you will be attending. Your envelopes will be left there for that Mass only. Please pick them up on your way into the Church.



If you are picking envelopes up for someone else, please follow the same protocol.

Lector Workbooks

The 2021 Workbooks for Lectors are here and available for those active in the Ministry of Lector in the Parish. The Workbooks begin with the start of the new Liturgical Year, the First Sunday of Advent, on November 29th.

Distribution will work this way: Please contact Fr. Michael, by e-mail or by phone message, during the days leading up to the Mass you will attend at which in intend to pick up your workbook. Leave a message with your name and the Mass you will attend in the days ahead (Wednesday morning, Saturday night or Sunday Morning). When you arrive, your book will be on the table in the entranceway. Your name will be on it. Please take it as you enter. And please, everyone else, refrain from touching it, or anything else that has no need of being touched.
