PRIESTS MEETING BISHOP

Last week, Bishop Dowd met with the priests of the Diocese via Zoom, regarding the statutes of the The old statutes were Presbyteral Council. published 30 years ago, and were quite out of date. He presented to the priests his proposal for new statutes, after explaining the mandate of the Presbyteral Council and some of the issues it will need to face in the year ahead. Primary in those statues is the provision for electing priests to the Council. The new statutes should be promulgated this week, with elections following in March. The key role of the Presbyteral Council is to assist the Diocesan Bishop with the governance of the Diocese. It is a consultative body mandated by the Code of Canon Law, and is designed to allow a greater degree of unity in decision making between the Bishop and his priests.



LENTEN DISCIPLINE

A gentle reminder of one part of our Lenten all Roman Catholics are invited to discipline: abstain from meat on every Friday throughout the year, unless it happens also to be a Solemnity. In Canada, we are permitted to swap that discipline with another act of charity, prayer or penance, so as to eat meat on a Friday if it is impractical or too difficult for us to abstain from meat that day. This "swapping" however, is not permitted during Lent. No meat on the six Fridays of Lent, nor on Good Friday. The reason for this discipline, by the way, is to unite ourselves to the love of God revealed when He died for us on the cross. This weekly discipline is an ongoing reminder for us of our call to live our lives in relationship to His love. In a secularized world, it is easy otherwise to forget. It is a common discipline throughout the world, which creates a bond of unity with all believers.


