## **CHURCH RE-OPENING**

With the end of the 'stay at home' order in early June, our province will be transitioning to a three stage process for re-opening the various places that have been restricted due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

In Stage One, Churches are still restricted to an attendance of 10 persons (no change from the 'stay at home/lock down' period).

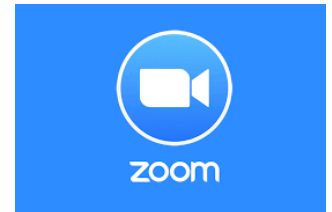
Currently, it seems that Stage One will begin this coming week and will continue for about 4 weeks. Moving to Stage Two will require a certain percentage of our population to be vaccinated.

In Stage Two, Churches will be able to partially open (restricted numbers based on capacity). This will, in effect, return us to a point where we can reopen for Sunday and Wednesday Masses. Although the exact time of the move to Stage Two is unknown, it does seem to be projected for early July.

The Parish website will always contain the most recent and up to date information about this situation, and when our reopening date is known, it will first be published there.

## **REGIONAL MEETING OF PRIESTS**

The priests of the Sudbury region met on Tuesday, May 25<sup>th</sup> via Zoom. The first hour of the meeting consisted of a presentation on the opioid crisis and homelessness in Sudbury, given by James Tregonning. Following that, updates and reports were given regarding the Fall celebration with Will Graham, Ecumenical and Interreligious efforts, and various other standing committees. Our next scheduled meeting will take place in September, and we are cautiously hopeful it can be done 'in person'.
