

STAGE ONE

We are grateful to have entered Stage One of Ontario's reopening plan a bit earlier than expected, and are even more grateful for the adjustment the Ontario Government made in allowing us the celebrate public Masses now, rather than waiting for Stage Two.

While in Stage One, we are permitted celebrations with an attendance of 15% of our maximum capacity. That translates into 42 people in St. John the Evangelist Church and 20 in St. Bernardine of Sienna Church.



For Garson, that should not be an issue, as our attendance has been quite a bit lower than that for the past year. For Skead however, attendance is normally higher than what is permitted, especially in the summer, and so they have their own way of fairly allowing their parishioners to attend on a rotating basis. For this reason, parishioners from Garson are asked to not attend there, until higher numbers are permitted.

For weekdays, Mass will be celebrated throughout the summer on Wednesday mornings. Come Fall, we will re-evaluate our schedule, based on the situation and the risks that may still be present.

Please be aware that masks are still mandatory for all who attend, social distancing is still required, and access to our washrooms is closed. Please also avoid complacency in the summer. There are many people who have not yet received their full vaccination, and the Delta variant poses some danger to everyone. Until the pandemic is over, love requires that we still use caution in our interactions with others. The dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass continues, so there is no reason to attend if you choose to remain home. Recall, however, that Sunday remains a Holy Day, and in lieu of attending Mass, some other form of spiritual practice (online/televised Liturgy, reading the Scriptures, praying the Rosary, etc.) should be followed.
