### **WORSHIP SAFE**

Last year, the Ontario Bishops collaborated to publish a document "Worship Safe" that provided guidelines for all Catholic Churches in the Province during the Covid-19 pandemic. It was the basis for the various protocols we have been following over the past 16 months.

Last week, this document was updated, based on the most current information available regarding the situation in our

Province. The Covid-19 teams from both our Parishes are currently reviewing this document, and the newest regulations our Bishop has issued which are based on it. We will implement the new regulations in due course, as we determine how best to do that in our own contexts. For the most part, the changes reflect an easing of some restrictions. Some may be implemented over the next few weeks in August, but our plan is to fully implement the changes beginning in September.
