## Stage 3

### **STAGE THREE OF ONTARIO'S RE-OPENING PLAN:**

On Friday, July 16<sup>th</sup>, Ontario entered Stage Three of its re-opening plan. For Churches, this removes a hard cap on the number of people permitted to attend Mass and other services, as long as we continue to wear masks and maintain the social distancing requirements as before.

In our Parish, washrooms are still unavailable, and the contact information of everyone attending must be taken. One change we will implement this weekend, however, is the altering our current protocol for exiting the Church, such that it will no longer be a requirement to leave directly after receiving Holy Eucharist. Instead, everyone is welcome to return to their seat following the reception of Holy Eucharist. The final blessing and dismissal will be given after everyone has received, and you will be free to linger a bit longer in prayer, if you choose. This is conditional on everyone respecting the required 2 meter distancing rule as you leave. Those who wish to continue leaving right after Communion are, of course, free to do so. The suspension of the Sunday obligation remains in effect.

### **GRANDPARENT'S DAY:**

Pope Francis has declared **Sunday, July 25<sup>th</sup>** as a day for celebrating grandparents and the elderly.

We encourage everyone to give special honour to their grandparents that day.

We will have a special blessing for them at our Sunday Masses that weekend.
