<u>SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION</u>: Anyone who wishes to begin the process of preparation for the Sacrament of Reconciliation may begin by picking up a registration form from Fr. Michael, following any Sunday Mass. The preparation process is open to any Roman Catholic living in Garson/Falconbridge/Skead who is (or will be) 7 years of age or older this year. Registration forms will be available beginning October 9/10 through until October 30/31 (four weekends). Please note that the celebration of Reconciliation is a prerequisite for beginning to receive Holy Eucharist in the Church.

The Sacrament of Confirmation will not be celebrated this year; rather, it will be offered in the Fall of 2022 to those who will be age 12 or older that year.

Baptism Preparation has continued throughout the pandemic, and so no change there. As a reminder, parents wishing the Baptism of their child should approach Fr. Michael following any Sunday Mass, and ask him for a registration form to begin the process.




