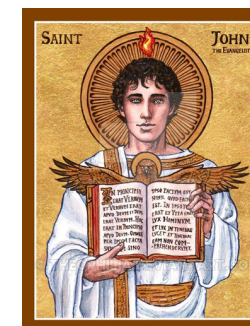

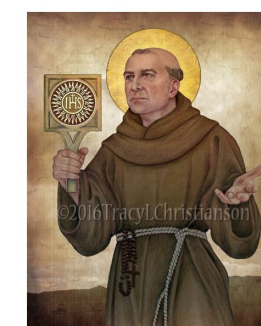

Today, every Catholic community and parish throughout the world is involved in this special event. It is a day that we

show that all Catholics are missionaries who have a role to play in spreading the message of the Gospel. We are being sent to be witnesses to what we have seen and heard, through prayer and personal sacrifices, for our brothers and sisters around the world. For as little as:

\$40 helps support a catechist for a month in remote areas of the missions.

\$80 provides for the work of Religious Sisters caring for orphaned children in Africa, Asia and Latin America.

\$100 assists poor children in boarding schools in the Amazon, Africa and Asia.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Anyone who wishes to begin the process of preparation for the Sacrament of Reconciliation may begin by picking up a registration form from Fr. Michael, following any Sunday Mass. The preparation process is open to any Roman Catholic living in Garson/Falconbridge/Skead who is (or will be) 7 years of age or older this year. **Registration forms are available until October 30/31 - next weekend.** Please note that the celebration of Reconciliation is a prerequisite for beginning to receive Holy Eucharist in the Church.



The Sacrament of Confirmation will not be celebrated this year; rather, it will be offered in the Fall of 2022 to those who will be age 12 or older that year.



Baptism Preparation has continued throughout the pandemic, and so no change there. As a reminder, parents wishing the Baptism of their child should approach Fr. Michael following any Sunday Mass, and ask him for a registration form to begin the process.
