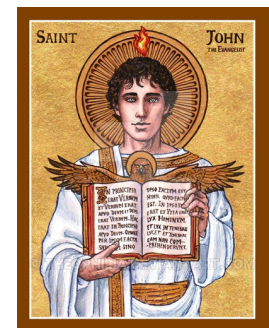

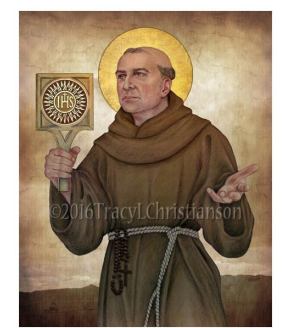

COVID-19 VACCINATION: There is no vaccination mandate for attending Mass in this Diocese, and there will be none unless our Bishop decrees otherwise. The corollary of this is the need to maintain 2 meter spacing from others and the need to continue wearing masks. Please show your concern for others by following these simple guidelines. Sudbury is still a "hotspot" for the virus, and so caution is required.



DONATION ENVELOPES: The 2022 donation envelopes will be available to pick up in the entranceway of the Church on the First Sunday of Advent, **next weekend**. If you used donation envelopes in 2021, you will automatically have a set issued to you for 2022.

If you are picking up envelopes for someone else, please let them know you are doing this, as not doing so has caused a small bit of confusion in previous years.

If you donate using Pre-Authorized Deductions (PAD), no envelopes will be issued to you. If you wish to begin donating using PAD, there are forms for this purpose in the main entranceway of the Church. Just fill one out and return it to the office via the collection basket, and we will look after the rest.

Thank you for your ongoing support of your Parish. Receipts for donations made this year will be issued in January, and a financial report for 2021 will be published soon after that.
