

Consecration to the Holy Family on the Feast of the Holy Family

The Knights of Columbus invite every family of our parishes to actively participate in the Consecration to the Holy Family, which will be held at our parish during the Masses on the Feast of the Holy Family, Sunday, December 26.

Families today face many struggles, particularly in this unprecedented time of Covid-19. Despite these struggles — and

partly as a result of conquering them — families have great capacity for love and joy, a joy that is strengthened through the peace and truth found in Christ. To assist families in living out this joy of Christ, Knights of Columbus Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William Lori has composed a prayer through which families may come together to consecrate themselves under the protection of the Holy Family. In this prayer, we ask for the aid or intercession of the perfect Son Jesus Christ, Mary the perfect mother, and Joseph who is a model for every father.

There are many ways we all can prepare in advance of the Consecration, for example:

Pray together as a family Intentionally fast from something

Attend Reconciliation Perform an act of charity

Prayer to Holy Family

O Lord Jesus, you lived in the home of Mary and Joseph in Nazareth. There you grew in age, wisdom and grace as you prepared to fulfill your mission as our Redeemer. We entrust our family to you.

O Blessed Mary, you are the Mother of our Savior. At Nazareth you cared for Jesus and nurtured him in the peace and joy of your home. We entrust our family to you.

O Saint Joseph, you provided a secure and loving home for Jesus and Mary, and gave us a model of fatherhood while showing us the dignity of work. We entrust our family to you.

Holy Family, we consecrate ourselves and our family to you. May we be completely united in a love that is lasting, faithful and open to the gift of new life. Help us to grow in virtue, to forgive one another from our hearts, and to live in peace all our days. Keep us strong in faith, persevering in prayer, diligent in our work, and generous toward those in need. May our home, O Holy Family, truly become a domestic church where we reflect your example in our daily life. Amen. Jesus, Mary and Joseph, pray for us!

<u>CHRISTMAS MASS ATTENDANCE</u>: Our protocols for the Christmas Masses this year will be identical to last year. In Skead, given their limited capacity, a reservation system will be in place. If Skead is not your normal place of worship, please do not attend there.



In Garson, we will follow a "first come, first entry" system; once the Church has reached maximum capacity, nobody else will be permitted inside. Capacity is based on 2 meter spacing. That is the current law in Ontario for Churches. A single family (even if just 3 - 4 people) will fill one pew. Two single people, or two couples, or one couple and one single person will do the same. We have only 18 available pews, so it's important to arrive early to ensure a seat for you and your family. We did not have to turn anyone away last year, and we hope this year will be the same, but it is up to you to arrive early enough to find a seat. Arriving last minute could be risky this year. The obligation to attend Holy Days (all Sundays, Christmas and Mother of God) is still suspended, so there is no necessity to attend a Christmas Mass in that regard. A viable option, then, is to make one of the Masses within the Octave of Christmas your "Christmas Mass" this year, if that is important to you. The Masses from December 26 -January 2 fall within the Octave, and are usually not as well attended. So too the Feast of the Epiphany. Whatever you decide, remember that attendance is very high risk during this current outbreak, the Omicron mutation is highly contagious, even with vaccination, and both our Churches are not particularly well ventilated.

Please note there will be no Mass on Saturday night on December 25th. The reason for this is that no Sunday Mass is permitted on Christmas Day; so, this year the only Sunday Masses permitted are on December 26th - Feast of the Holy Family.

If, due to unfortunate circumstances, the ever changing situation of the pandemic forces the government to suspend attendance at Church services, that fact will be published on the Home Page of our website. Please check there for the latest updates in this regard.
