



During this month of January, everyone is invited to participate in the consultation phase of the Synodal Process in our Diocese. You may to this individually, if you choose. For this, you will need to access the online Synod page of the Diocesan website: www.dioceseofsaultstemarie.org/synod. Once there, click on "Link - Questions for the Synodal Process" and follow it through. This must be submitted online by the end of January.

If you wish to participate as a Parish community, you can do this on Sunday, January 16th immediately following the 10:30am Mass at St. John the Evangelist. On that day, all parishioners are invited to participate. Simply remain in the Church after Mass, and Fr. Michael will guide us through a process whereby everyone will have the opportunity to speak to any of the questions posed by the synod documents. It would be extremely helpful if, before this gathering, participants had read and thought about the 10 questions beforehand. 20 + C + M + B + 22

That is the current year, the crosses which point to Christ, and the names of the Magi (by tradition): Caspar, Melchior and Balthazar. It is also the Latin Phrase: Christus Mansionem Benedicat (May Christ Bless this House). If you wish, you may also pray this prayer at the same time (or a similar prayer using your own words):

Bless, O Lord God almighty, this home, that in it there may be health, purity, the strength of victory, humility, goodness and mercy, the fulfillment of Your law, the thanksgiving to God the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. And may this blessing remain upon this home, upon all who dwell herein, and upon all those who visit. Through Christ our Lord.
