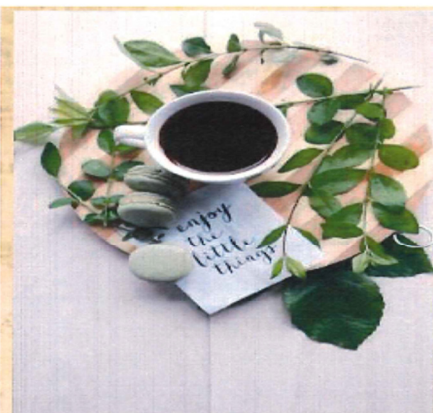

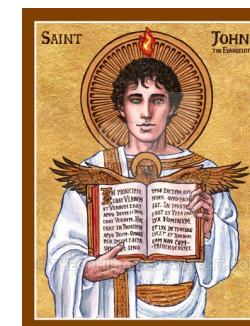

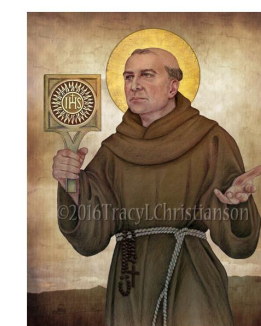

SYNODAL PROCESS IN OUR PARISH - PUBLIC MEETING CANCELLED:

Due to the new Provincial regulations pertaining to the pandemic, which limit indoor gatherings to no more than 5 people, we had to cancel the public consultation meeting in our Parish. Given the time lines imposed by the whole Synodal process, it is unlikely we will be able to re-schedule this meeting at a later date. That leaves only the option of individually participating, for those who choose.

For those who wish to participate individually, you will need to access the online Synod page of the Diocesan website: www.dioceseofsaultstemarie.org/synod. Once there, click on "**Link - Questions for the Synodal Process**" and follow it through. This must be submitted online by the end of January.

For those who find the questions difficult or confusing, the Bishop's office passes on this tidbit: **Don't worry about it. Just choose any question and write down what you want to tell the Pope, even if it has nothing to do with the question being asked.** Once received, the answers will be collated and submitted, first to the Canadian Church, and then to the Vatican.

COVID-19: UPDATE ON OUR SERVICES



COVID-19 PANDEMIC ... NEW REGULATIONS

As is well known, the Omicron variant of the Covid virus is currently ravaging our communities and, in response, has required the government of Ontario to issue new regulations. There is no huge difference for Churches between the old regulations and the new. Although capacity is now limited to 50%, we already were restricted by the 2 meter spacing regulation, which would never allow us to reach 50% capacity anyway.

Where we are impacted is the part of the regulation which limits indoor (non-worship related) gatherings to no more than 5 people. Due to this regulation, all committees, groups and other non-worship related gatherings at the Church are bound by this 5 person limit. It is the reason why the CWL is unable to meet, and also why we were not able to proceed with the gathering for the synodal process in our Parish, originally scheduled for January 16th.

While these limitations are, of course, most unfortunate and continue to impact our community life in a negative way, we are reminded that the reason for them is to protect the most vulnerable members of our family. As such, being respectful of the regulations is, as Pope Francis reminds us, an act of love and selflessness.

Hope, however, is present, with an easing of restrictions on the horizon! Currently, the Provincial Government is planning on lifting ALL capacity limits for religious services in mid-March. Although things can, obviously, change quickly, it does now look as if we will see some semblance of "normal" by the Third Sunday of Lent.

OFFICIAL PRAYER OF THE SYNOD
