

LENT IS APPROACHING

Ash Wednesday is on March 2nd, just ten days away. Mass that day will be celebrated at St. John the Evangelist



Church at 6pm, rather than the usual morning hour. As the beginning of Lent approaches, it is appropriate to prayerfully consider how God wishes to work in our lives during this period of inner conversion through prayer, fasting and works of love. Those three traditional "actions" of Lent are, after all, simply the framework through which our hearts are opened more fully to the One Who calls us to be more fully like Him, and most especially by imitating His example of love and mercy. As far as Parish Lenten activities are concerned, we hope to outline a few devotional activities in next week's bulletin that we plan on introducing for Lent. Also, a daily reflection booklet will be made available to everyone who wishes. Everyone is invited to enter fully into this coming Season of grace, according to the way God's personal call to you suggests.

COVID-19: UPDATE ON OUR SERVICES

Some have asked about the changes that might be coming about

in our Churches vis-a-vis the loosening of pandemic restrictions. As of now, there is no change: the latest relaxation of restrictions has no practical impact on our Liturgies, as we still need to maintain 2 meter spacing. That may change on March 1st. There is a very real possibility that we enter Lent with no restrictions. save the ongoing (for now) requirement of masking. For that to happen, the government of Ontario (and the Sudbury Health Unit) would have to lift the restrictions AND the Bishop of our Diocese would have to issue a decree reflecting that change. When that happens, we will happily make everyone aware of it. For now, please continue to be patient. Please also be respectful of the ongoing need to protect the most vulnerable of our people. Whether it is Covid. the flu. or any other illness you have, please stay home until you are well.
