OFFICIAL SYNOD PRAYER

A REMINDER: As previously announced, there is no longer a "Covid Bubble Zone" around the Minister of Holy Eucharist. There is no need to maintain silence within a 2 meter radius of the Minister, so no need to wait 2 meters away for "The Body of Christ" proclamation. The protocol returns to our pre-pandemic norm: while the person ahead of you is receiving Holy Eucharist (or, even better, 2 persons ahead), you make a reverence. In our Parish and in our Diocese, that reverence takes the form of a simple bow. Then proceed to receive as usual. The Minister of Holy Eucharist will wear a mask (mandatory); masking is optional for everyone else.

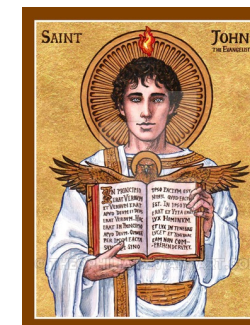

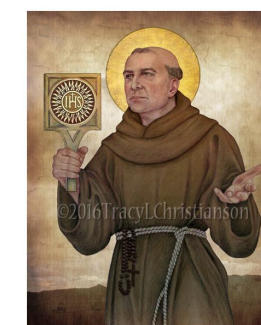
