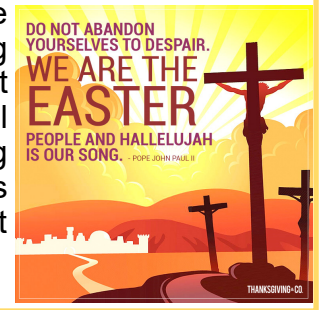

DIVINE MERCY PRAYER SERVICE: Join us on Divine Mercy Sunday (April 24th) in St. John's Church for the Divine Mercy Prayer Service. It will begin at 3pm. During the veneration of the Divine Mercy image, we will not be permitted any physical contact this year, due to the pandemic restrictions of our Diocese (same as on Good Friday).

We do not pretend that life is all beauty. We are aware of darkness and sin, of poverty and pain. But we know Jesus has conquered sin and passed through His own pain to the glory of the Resurrection. And we live in the light of His Paschal Mystery - the mystery of His Death and Resurrection. "We are an Easter People and Alleluia is our song!". We are not looking for a shallow joy but rather a joy that comes from faith, that grows through unselfish love, that respects the "fundamental duty of love of neighbour, without which it would be unbecoming to speak of Joy". We realize that joy is demanding; it demands unselfishness; it demands a readiness to say with Mary: "Be it done unto me according to thy word". **St. John Paul II, 1986.**
