OFFICIAL SYNOD PRAYER

We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name. With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts; Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it. A REMINDER: As previously announced, there is no longer a "Covid Bubble Zone" around the Minister of Holy Eucharist. There is no need to maintain silence within a 2 meter radius of the Minister, so no need to wait 2 meters away for "The Body of Christ" proclamation. The protocol returns to our pre-pandemic norm: while the person ahead of you is receiving Holy Eucharist (or, even better, 2 persons ahead), you make a reverence. In our Parish and in our Diocese, that reverence takes the form of a simple bow. Then proceed to receive as usual.

The Minister of Holy Eucharist will wear a mask (mandatory); masking is optional for everyone else.

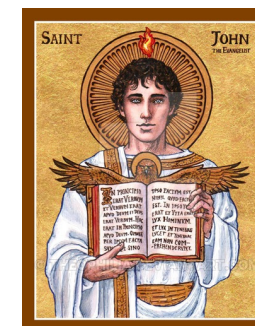

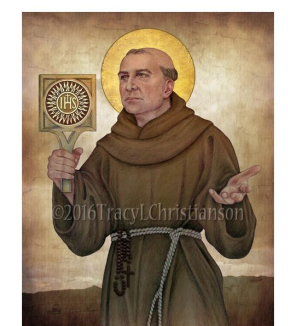

56th WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY, MAY 29TH: Pope Francis asks the world of communication to do something using only one word --Listen! A good relationship begins with listening and an open heart without prejudice. It is quite the art to be able to listen, one that people seem to be losing the ability to do. The pope states, "Listening corresponds to the humble style of God. It is the action that allows God to reveal himself as the One who, by speaking, creates man and woman in his image, and by listening recognizes them as his partners in dialogue. God loves humanity: that is why he addresses his word to them, and why he "inclines his ear to listen to them ...Saint Francis of Assisi exhorted his brothers to 'incline the ear of the heart.' Pope Francis has invited the whole church to listen in order to learn to be a synodal church. His invitation is to rediscover listening as an essential condition for good communication. Let us make it a regular part of the dialogue. "I'm listening."
