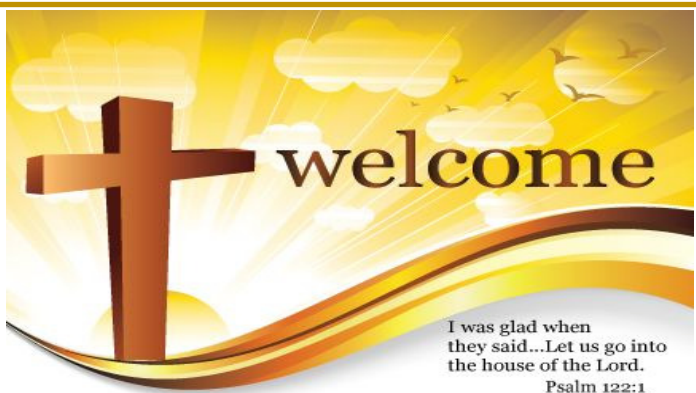
OFFICIAL SYNOD PRAYER

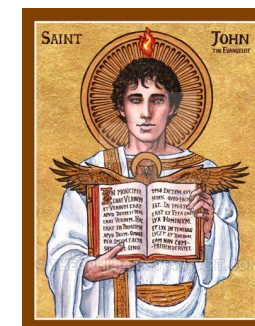

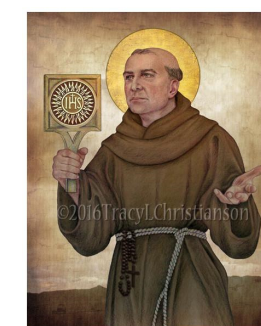

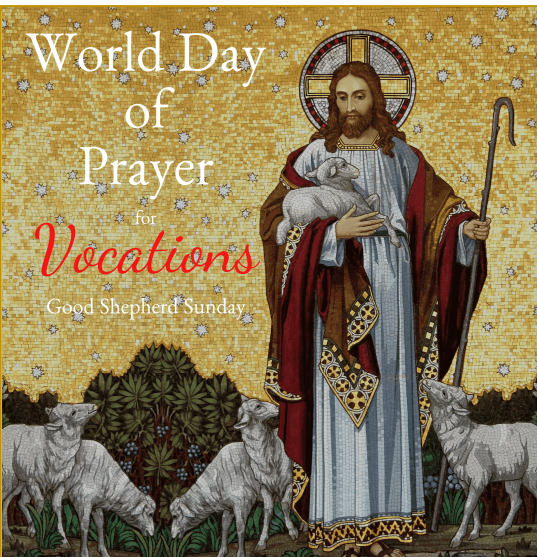
