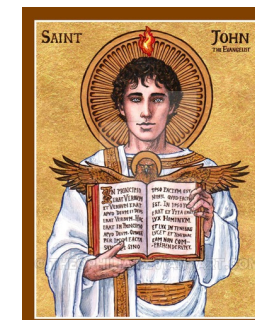

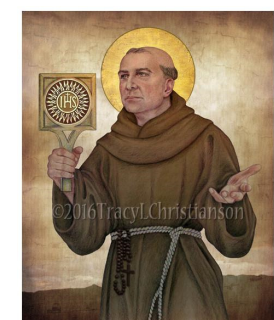

Bless all fathers as they care for their families.

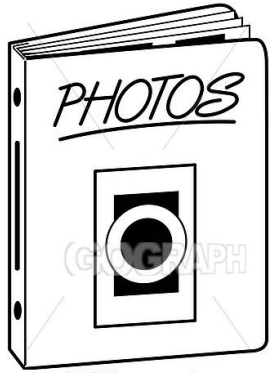
Give them strength and wisdom, tenderness and patience.
