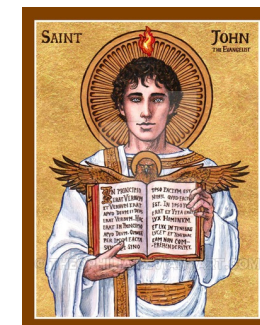

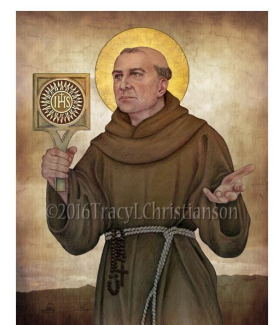

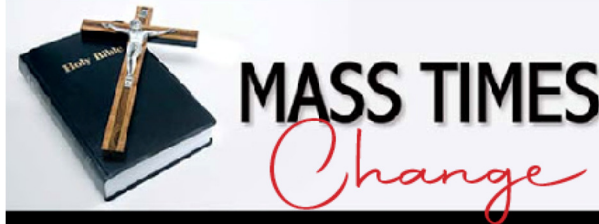

### CHANGE IN WEEKDAY MASS TIMES:

Beginning in July, the weekday Masses on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday will return to their pre-pandemic time of 9:30am.



**SEALING OF PARKING LOT:** This week, the parish parking lot will be re-sealed, with the lines re-painted. **We ask that parishioners use the lot across the street for parking this week.** This maintenance job was originally scheduled for 2019, but was not completed due to equipment problems. During the pandemic, due to our financial uncertainty, it was put on hold. So, it is more than past its due date for this job.

### AN UPDATE ON THE SYNODAL PROCESS



The consultation phase in our Diocese is now done and Diocesan staff are working on the synthesis and report from the diocese. Once it is ready in English and French, participants in the process will be notified. It will be published on the diocesan website, and then it will be sent eventually to the Vatican.
