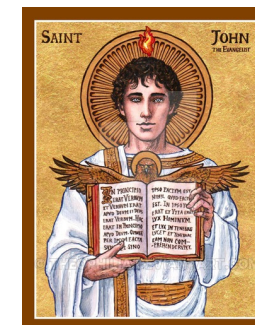

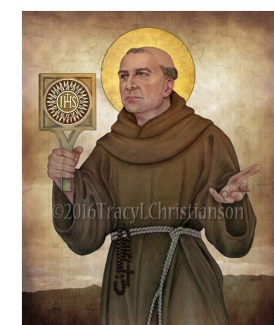

REGISTRATION FORMS FOR RECONCILIATION/HOLY EUCHARIST

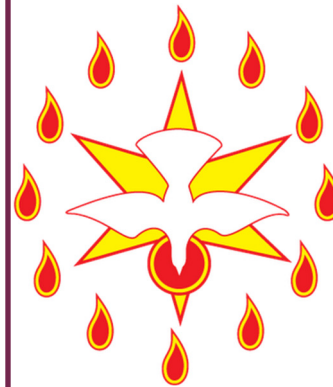
