PARISH LIGHTING: Some have noticed a problem with our fluorescent lights in some areas (bathrooms and kitchen, most notably). This is not a new problem, but is exacerbated by high humidity, as fluorescent lights don't do well in moisture. To solve this problem, we have switched the worst lights to LEDs, which have no problem with wet areas. As a bonus, they also consume less electricity. As the other fluorescent bulbs burn out, they will also be replaced with LEDs.

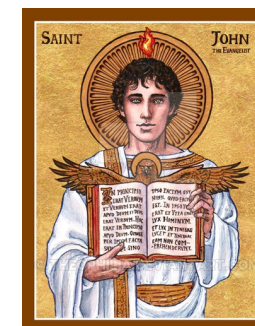

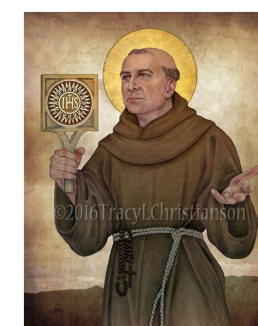
