

Canadian Mission Initiative: Our Bishop, Thomas Dowd, has renamed the November Special Collection (taking place this weekend) to the Canadian Mission Initiative. It used to be called the Bishop's Annual Appeal. The money raised through your donations will part of the 30 million dollar reconciliation fund the Canadian Bishops promised to raise over the next 5 years. Our Diocese has committed to raising \$350,000 of that, over those 5 years (\$70,000/year).

New Covid Policy The Bishop has issued an updated Covid policy, which takes effect on **December 1st**. You may read it in the October edition of the Gazette (Diocesan website). As a summary, the dispensation from attending Mass every Sunday, issued on March 19, 2020, has been abrogated. Not attending Sunday Mass after December 1st would be a sin against the Third Commandment (normal exceptions, like illness, being taken into account). The mask mandate has been entirely lifted, save

for the priest in the Confessional, who is still required to wear one (and Fr. Michael will still wear one while giving out Communion). The prohibition COVID-19 from receiving Eucharist from the Chalice remains for the time being.
