

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: On Saturday this weekend, the children of the Parish experienced the grace of God's forgiveness that is offered through the Sacrament of Penance. We rejoice with them, and are invited to continue praying for them as they now look to begin their preparation for entering into the weekly reception of Holy Eucharist.



FAMILY CONSECRATION: Each year, the Knights of Columbus sponsor a family consecration on the Feast of the Holy Family. This year, that Solemnity falls on a Friday (January 30th), rather than on a Sunday. In order to allow the greatest number possible of families to participate, we will be invited to make the consecration at home. The prayer cards for that will be handed out, following Mass, on the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God (which falls on Sunday, January 1st this year). The consecration prayer will also be printed in the Christmas bulletin next weekend, for those who wish to make the consecration on the actual Solemnity (on Friday).
