



New Covid Policy The Bishop has issued an updated Covid policy, which took effect on **December 1st**. You may read it in the October edition of the Gazette (Diocesan website). As a summary, the dispensation from attending Mass every Sunday, issued on March 19, 2020, has been abrogated. Not attending

Sunday Mass is a sin against the Third Commandment (normal exceptions, like illness, being taken into account). The mask mandate has been entirely lifted, save for the priest in the Confessional, who is COVID-19 still required to wear one (and Fr. Michael will still wear one while 🏬 ministering Holy Eucharist). The prohibition from receiving Eucharist



from the Chalice remains for the time being. The sign of peace may be exchanged in any form that is comfortable to everyone. As always, if you are sick, you should not attend Church (or any other group venue). Hand sanitizer continues to be available for those who wish to use it. Although masks are optional, those who wish to wear one are encouraged to do so. Please respect the comfort level of those around you.
