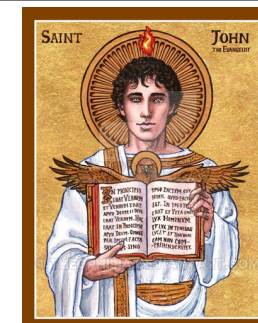

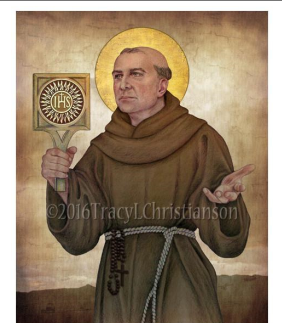

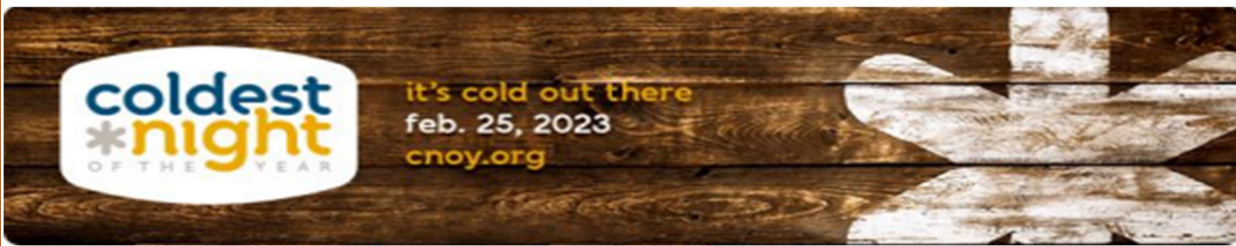
Coldest Night of The Year Fundraising Event
