

#### A LENTEN JOURNEY - A FREE ONLINE SCRIPTURE STUDY

Many have followed the various Lenten journeys offered by them in past years, and are familiar with the format. As Scott Hahn tells us:

"For the last seven years, the St. Paul Center has premiered its newest production of the Journey Through Scripture Bible study series during Lent and 2023 is no exception. I'm inviting you to join me this Ash Wednesday, February 22<sup>nd</sup> for our newest study, "Holy is His Name."

All of us are called to be holy. Scripture tells us that God's will for us is our sanctification (1 Thessalonians 4:3). But we're never quite told what holiness is.

Come with me on my quest to search for the meaning of holiness as it is found in the Scriptures. Together we'll see how God transmits His holiness to His people—through creation, right worship, and more—and ultimately transforms them through the sharing of His divine life."


