**AN EPIPHANY BLESSING**



For those who wish to bless their home (which is also a blessing for all who live and visit that home), you may take a piece of blessed chalk with you after Mass and write the following over one or more of the entrances to your home:

**20 + C + M + B + 24**

That is the current year, the crosses which point to Christ, and the names of the Magi (by tradition): Caspar, Melchior and Balthazar. It also represents the Latin Phrase: Christus Mansionem Benedicat (May Christ Bless this House). If you wish, you may also pray this prayer at the same time (or a similar prayer using your own words):

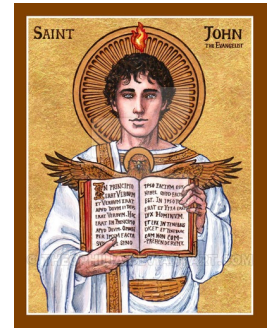

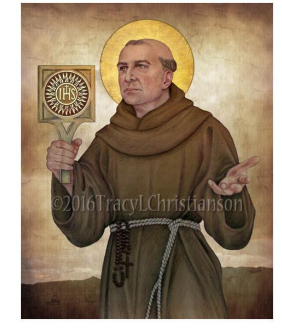

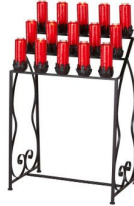
