



All fluorescent lights in both Churches have been replaced with LEDs at no cost to us.

We are still waiting for quotes for installing a railing down the center of our front stairs at St. John's.

Bishop Thomas Dowd will be in both Parishes for a Pastoral Visit from January 26 -February 2, 2025. We will plan for that visit at our two Fall meetings.
