Upon the advice of "The Pontifical Commission for the Protection of Minors" (*Tutela Minorum*) in 2016, Pope Francis asked that an appropriate day be designated as a "Day of Prayer" for the victims/ survivors of sexual abuse. The purpose of the day of prayer and reflection is both to engender healing and to raise awareness.

In Sudbury, a Prayer Service for victims and survivors of clergy sexual abuse will be held at Our Lady of Lourdes Grotto in Sudbury at 4:00 pm, on Sunday, September 15th, weather permitting. If the weather will not allow the Prayer Service to be held outdoors at the Grotto, you are all invited to gather at Christ the King Church, Sudbury. Bishop Thomas Dowd is inviting everyone to this Prayer Service which he will preside, and he asks that we remember in a special way the victims and survivors of clergy sexual abuse in our prayers.

HOST FAMILIES NEEDED: Our Parish is hosting a NET retreat for the grade 6 students at St. John's School on Friday, October 4th. We have been asked to provide hosting for the 8 young missionaries who will be giving the retreat. They need a place to stay from October 3rd to October 6th. They require housing for 2 individuals per home, so 4 homes are needed. Besides a place to stay, they will require breakfast each morning, a bag lunch, and dinner at night. 

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS COUNCIL 6074 RECEIVES TOP AWARD

For the fraternal year 2023 – 2024, our Knights of Columbus Centennial Council 6074 has received the distinction of Star Council, the international organization's top award for local councils.

□ Provided bingo volunteers to support the fund raising activities of both St. Andrew's Parish and Inner City Home.
