Upon the advice of "The Pontifical Commission for the Protection of Minors" (Tutela Minorum) in 2016, Pope Francis asked that an appropriate day be designated as a "Day of Prayer" for the victims/survivors of sexual abuse. The purpose of the day of prayer and reflection is both to engender healing and to raise awareness.

In Sudbury, a Prayer Service for victims and survivors of clergy sexual abuse will be held at Our Lady of Lourdes Grotto in Sudbury at 4:00 pm, on Sunday, September 15<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting. If the weather will not allow the Prayer Service to be held outdoors at the Grotto, you are all invited to gather at Christ the King Church, Sudbury, Bishop Thomas Dowd is inviting everyone to this Prayer Service which he will preside, and he asks that we remember in a special way the victims and survivors of clergy sexual abuse in our prayers.




