



PRAYING THE ROSARY DURING THE JUBILEE YEAR OF HOPE

Throughout the Jubilee Year, the Rosary will be prayed before every anticipated Mass on Saturday, beginning at 3:50pm. Come and pray the Rosary of Hope together.



A PILGRIMAGE OF HOPE? Central to every Jubilee Year experience is the pilgrimage. It is deeply rooted in our tradition, going back to the very first centuries. There are many forms of pilgrimage, of course, but the classic form is to journey to a holy site as a means of prayer, manifested in the various physical, emotional and spiritual challenges that such a journey inevitably entails, while focussed on the destination. In a sense, it is an analogy of our lives. In January, a survey will be conducted in our 2 parishes to see if there is interest in some form of pilgrimage for the Holy Year in 2025. One option will be a one day pilgrimage to the Martyr's Shrine in Midland. The other option will be a three or four day pilgrimage to either Montreal (the Oratory of St. Joseph) or Quebec (Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré).

If there is enough interest in such a pilgrimage, Fr. Michael will do some further planning to outline the cost and itinerary. He would also accompany the pilgrims on any pilgrimage chosen. We are asked, for now, to prayerfully consider this possibility as a part of our Jubilee experience.
