



PARISH COUNCIL

Your Parish Pastoral Council met this past Wednesday. The full minutes of that meeting are published on our parish website. This is a very brief summary (some highlights) of those minutes:

A decision to switch from plastic inserts to glass for our Divine Mercy candles, for environmental reasons;

A decision to inquire about the possibility of a parish photo album for this Jubilee year;

Easter Memorial Flower donations will be earmarked for the Hospice again this year;

A possible June BBQ following a Sunday Mass - decision to be made at April meeting;

A review of the 2024 financial statements - parish report for bulletin is pending;

A discussion about the 2025 budget, which is not yet finalized; no extraordinary expenses are planned, so it will be quite similar to the 2024 budget.
