



#### AN EPIPHANY BLESSING

For those who wish to bless their home (which is also a blessing for all who live in and visit that home), you may take a piece of blessed chalk with you after Mass and write the following over one or more of the entrances to your home:

$$20 + C + M + B + 25$$

That is the current year, the crosses which point to Christ, and the names of the Magi (by tradition): Caspar, Melchior and Balthazar. It also represents the Latin Phrase: Christus Mansionem Benedicat (May Christ Bless this House). If you wish, you may also pray this prayer at the same time (or a similar prayer using your own words):

Bless, O Lord God almighty, this home, that in it there may be health, purity, the strength of victory, humility, goodness and mercy, the fulfillment of Your law, the thanksgiving to God the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. And may this blessing remain upon this home, upon all who dwell herein, and upon all those who visit. Through Christ our Lord.
