Please feel free to take one or more home; the larger ones we use during Mass, and so we ask that you return those to the Ministers of Hospitality after every Mass.



RECYCLE YOUR OLD PRESCRIPTION GLASSES AND HEARING AIDS

If you have unused prescription glasses or hearing aids, we will take them on behalf of the Lions Club. These used glasses are sent to a collection centre in Canada, cleaned and sorted then sent overseas to countries where people do not have ready access to eyeglasses. The same goes for old hearing aids. Both can be placed in the "Lost and Found" box located behind the door holding the bulletin board on the side of the "Last Supper" stained glass window. Please put the glasses and hearing aids in a zip lock bag so we know they are not 'lost and found', but rather donations.

BISHOP THOMAS DOWD will be speaking at Our Lady of Hope Parish on Saturday, May 31st. The theme is **"THE POWER ON HIGH"**. Confessions are available. There will be outstanding music, the Rosary and Saturday liturgy Mass beginning at 8am. A small reception with cake and coffee is to be held afterwards. The Ascension colour is white, so we invite you to come wearing something white, if you have it. All are welcome; please plan on attending.



DIVINE MERCY CANDLES: Through the offerings of those who donate for the burning of the Divine Mercy Candles at St. John's, we are able to support our adopted children through Chalice, as well as care for the poor in other ways - the Garson Food Bank, Sudbury Hospice Foundation and the Pregnancy Care Centre and Infant Food Bank have all benefited from candle offerings. The minimum amount requested is \$7/candle, ALL of which goes to the poor (the parish donates the cost of the candle).

Requests to have a candle burned may be made simply by putting the money in an envelope marked "Divine Mercy" and leaving it in the collection basket.
