Earlier this year, a survey was taken in the Parish to determine what, if any, interest there was in a Jubilee Pilgrimage of some sort this year. Six responses were received, and of the options presented, all six expressed an interest in a one day Pilgrimage to the Martyr's Shrine in Midland.

The date for this day pilgrimage has now been selected. It is <u>Thursday, May 22nd</u>. Fr. Michael will drive our group down to the Shrine that morning, and we will celebrate Mass together there. We will have the opportunity to tour the Shrine and to spend time on the grounds, including the Mission.

There is room for 7 on this pilgrimage, including Fr. Michael. The 6 who previously expressed an interest have preference, but some may choose not to go, so there may be room for others. **There is currently room for 3 more pilgrims**.

If you are interested in this one day pilgrimage, please let Fr. Michael know by email or phone to reserve your spot (if you are one of the 6 who previously expressed an interest) or to be placed on the 'standby' list in case there is room for others. The cost will simply be the gas for the van and the admission price to the grounds. Lunch and dinner will be the responsibility of each person.
