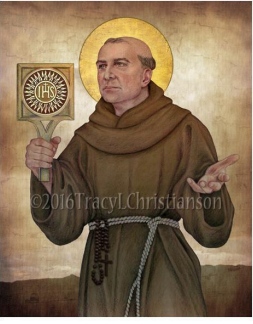

- † **Bishop's Pastoral Visit:** October 18 - 26, 2025. We will have our next PPC meeting with the Bishop. The itinerary of his visit will be planned over the summer.
- † **Jubilee Parish Photo Album:** 88 parishioners have signed up to have their photo taken. Shut ins will have their photos taken at their homes by volunteers.
- † **A Fall Event:** To be planned for while the Bishop is here. Perhaps a dinner.
- † **Kneelers for the Church:** The PPC was unanimous in its support of proceeding with the reinstallation of kneelers in our Church. The work will begin immediately; a local carpenter has been hired to build them for us.
