



Michael will pray over the individual graves of anyone upon the request of family and friends who are gathered.



SACRAMENT OF THE SICK: As we do every First Friday of the month, the Sacrament of the Sick will be celebrated at Mass on Friday, November 7th for all those who have any sort of illness and who would like to receive this Sacrament. NICENE CREED DURING THE JUBILEE YEAR: This year is the 1700th anniversary of the Ecumenical Council which gave us the Nicene Creed. Bishop Dowd has asked that parishes in our Diocese use this form of the Creed at all Masses during the Jubilee Year.
