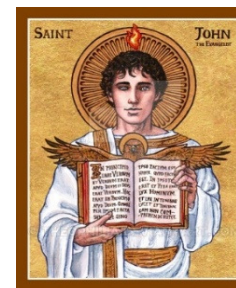

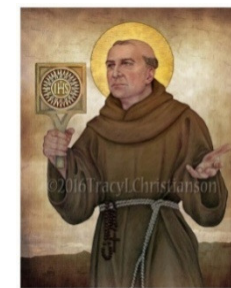

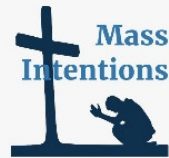

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS RECRUITMENT SUNDAY: This is Recruitment Sunday for the Knights of Columbus. For any men of the Parish who are considering joining the K. of C., there are members available following both Masses in Garson who can answer all your questions.



Please remember that Fr. Michael is required to celebrate a Mass for all parishioners every Sunday (Missa Pro Populo). That means there are only 2 Masses (one in Garson and one in Skead) that are available for Mass stipends. Since Skead only has 1 Mass each week, they will always have priority for the Sunday Mass stipend. Only if they do not have one scheduled for Sunday can Fr. Michael offer one instead on Sunday morning in Garson. That leaves, on most Sundays, the Saturday evening anticipated Mass available for requested Masses in Garson. Fr. Michael tries to schedule the requested Masses in such a way that intentions requested, and those they are requested by, are fairly balanced. For that reason, if you always request a Sunday Mass, you may find it takes quite a while for it to be celebrated (there are currently some requests dating back to last summer). It’s worth noting that there is no difference between a Sunday Mass and a weekday Mass, as far as the grace provided through the celebration of the Mass goes.
